

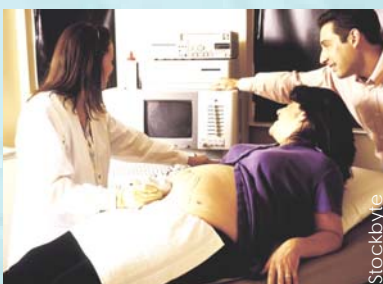


TEN WAYS THAT PHYSICIANS CAN ASSIST A LOCAL PREGNANCY MEDICAL CENTER TO MAKE AN IMPACT FOR LIFE



1. Accept (or initiate!) an invitation to go to breakfast or lunch with the CEO and Nurse Manager when they call, in order to learn more about the vision of the Pregnancy Medical Clinic (PMC).
2. Ask the CEO to arrange for you to spend half a day at the PMC caring for clients and helping them understand their options based on good medical information. This will enable you to see first-hand the services offered. As well, your presence will greatly encourage the staff, especially if you reserve a little time to hear from them about their specific roles at the clinic.
3. Influence medical students and residents by example. Take them to the PMC to familiarize them with the services and needs. Instill an understanding of the mission field that exists right at their back door!
4. Give to the PMC ministry in your community, knowing that these dollars will translate into lives saved and souls saved. Host a table at the annual support banquet.
5. Offer referral slips to patients in your practice who are abortion vulnerable, offering them a free ultrasound examination and further counseling about their options at the PMC, which has no financial interest in their choice.
6. Donate a certain number of hours for your practice to care for an abortion-vulnerable PMC client needing follow-up care. Your influence could help keep her strong in her life-affirming decision!
7. Make an appointment with the Nurse Manager at the PMC to find out what kind of in-service training for staff their and volunteers, or opportunities for public speaking on medical issues that you could provide occasionally.
8. Offer to lead a devotion with the staff and/or board members to share why the sanctity of human life is essential to your medical practice. Ask if you can pray for abortion-vulnerable clients by first name on a regular basis.
9. Arrange a tour at the PMC for your colleagues so that you can help heighten awareness of life-affirming services in the medical community.
10. Do something that really counts – volunteer your time to work in the PMC. Help save one baby who may change the world. Protect women's health. Help spiritually transform lives. Get involved in something only God can accomplish!
